Word of Caution !!

- Risk of a late sliding of the retroperitoneal fat under/in front of the mesh
- Desufflation after laparoscopic hernia repair tends to elevate the lower edge of the mesh prosthesis
- Predisposes to migration of the prosthesis from the space between the mesh and the muscle
- Presence of a direct hernia
